Following the letter of 24 July 2024, it is my pleasure to inform you that the Government of the Republic of Croatia decided at its session on 22 August 2024 to nominate Ms Dubravka Śuica as the candidate for a Member of the European Commission. Prior to the decision of the Government, Ms Śuica's candidature was also positively assessed by the European Affairs Committee of the Croatian Parliament.

Our decision to nominate again Ms. Suiva for this uniquely important position speaks of the results of her work as Vice-President of the European Commission for Democracy and Demography. Beside her role in the Commission, Ms Suiva has held the position of Vice President of the European People's Party (FPP). I am particularly pleased that Ms Suiva was also once more elected to the European Parliament, making this the fourth time that she has gained the trust of the Croatian citizens. At these elections, the list of Croatian Democratic Union (11DZ), which I personally carried, achieved the best result within the EPP family, winning 6 out of 12 available MFPs mandates.

I am convinced that Ms Śnica's extensive political experience at the national and European level, as well as her leadership and expertise, will highly benefit the new Commission. I am pleased that our proposal also takes into account the diversity and gender balance within the new College of Commissioners. I look forward to our upcoming discussions regarding Ms Śnica's portfolio in the new Commission's architecture. Ms Śnica's Curriculum Vitae is attached berewith.
